The withdrawal of<br>one of the two licensed drugs for this<br>indication from the market with the<br>introduction of a new licensed agent.   | Update                                       | Published<br>October 2014  | Section 15.2 on heparin induced<br>thrombocytopenia updated to reflect<br>changes in drug licensing and to ensure<br>consistency with guidelines from the British<br>Committee for Standards in Haematology. |
| 11/10/2011 | In the Wells Scoring system in Annex 5 it<br>appears the category of 'previously<br>documented DVT' has been left out. The<br>range of scores given in Annex 5 is -2 to 9<br>when the highest score you can achieve<br>using the categories given is 8. This<br>suggests that previous DVT has been<br>excluded as a risk factor. | Update                                       | Published<br>November 2011 | Section 9.2 and Annex 5 covering<br>diagnostic algorithms revised to clarify use<br>of the Wells Scoring system.   |
